## HOW TO APPLY LICART AND FLECTOR

Using Licart and Flector is simple. Just peel the adhesive backing from the Licart or Flector patch, and apply directly to the site of your pain.

You can use the Licart or Flector patch in a variety of places on your body. The recommended dose is one patch to the most painful area, once daily for Licart and twice daily for Flector.

If Licart or Flector begins to peel off, the edges of the patch may be taped down. For ankles, knees, and elbows, you can use a mesh netting sleeve to keep the patch in place as long as air is still able to pass through.



Apply once a day



Apply 2x a day every 12 hours

# WHEN TO NOT USE LICART OR FLECTOR

- Do not apply Licart or Flector to damaged skin.
- Do not wear the patch when showering or bathing. You can remove and reapply after washing using tape to secure the patch if necessary.
- Wash your hands after applying, handling, or removing Licart or Flector.
- Do not cut Licart or Flector.
- Avoid contact with your eyes.
- Before taking Licart or Flector, tell your doctor if you have a history of cardiovascular, liver or kidney disease.
